## What do the results mean?

- Fully implemented Leapfrog’s recommended quality and safety leap.
- Good progress in implementing Leapfrog’s recommended quality and safety leap.

For rural hospitals, not all leaps apply. The Quality Index (made up of 27 NQF-endorsed Safe Practices) is the first leap that applies to rural hospitals.

## LEGEND

**LEAP 1: CPOE** – choose a hospital that requires its staff to use computers to order medications, tests and procedures. This is called a Computerized Physician Order Entry system (CPOE).

**LEAP 2: ICU Staffing** – choose a hospital with an intensive care unit (ICU) that is staffed by doctors and other caregivers who have special training in critical care. These are doctors are called ‘intensivists’.

**LEAP 3: High Risk Treatments (Evidence-Based Hospital Referral)** – select a hospital with lots of experience and the best results for specific procedures, surgeries or conditions. This is known as Evidence Based Hospital Referral (High risk procedures). Procedures, Conditions and Recommended Volumes for High Risk Treatments:

1. **CABG** Coronary Artery Bypass Graft ≥ 450 / year
2. **PCI** Percutaneous Coronary Intervention ≥ 400 / year
3. **AAAR** Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Repair ≥ 50 / year
4. **PR** Pancreatic Resection ≥ 11 / year
5. **Esog** Esophagectomy ≥ 13 / year
6. **HRD** High-risk Delivery: Expected birth weight < 1500 grams; Gestational age < 32 weeks; or Prenatal diagnosis of major congenital anomaly Neonatal ICU1 with Average Daily Census ≥ 15

**Leap 4: Leapfrog Safe Practices Score** – select a hospital that has a high Leapfrog Safe Practices Score. This means it has put in place 27 procedures to reduce preventable medical mistakes. More information on the [Leapfrog Safe Practices Score](#).
